# VOTE RESPONSIBLY

## PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID

Based on the COMELEC guidelines, presenting a COVID-19 vaccination card or a negative COVID-19 test result prior to voting is not required. And if a voter may be suspected of having COVID-19 or is positive, he or she still has the right to vote. **They will not be turned away.** COMELEC has its own isolation polling places reserved for people experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.

If you are planning to vote on May 9 and with the detection of the **more transmissible BA.2.12** in the country, please make sure **that you have maximum protection from COVID-19:**

1. Get vaccinated
2. Get boosted if eligible.
3. Wear your face masks and follow public health standards.
4. If you have COVID-19 symptoms, isolate immediately and call your doctor or LGU for guidance.

To **prevent the spread of COVID-19** on Election Day, May 9, here are the **standard health and safety protocols to be followed:**

1. Temperature checks
2. Physical distancing
3. Wearing of face masks at all times
4. Frequent disinfection of the hands
